Dear Director Platts,

On June 25, 2021, I vetoed 226 earmarked appropriations totaling \$152.5 million contained in the FY 2021-22 General Appropriations Act. These earmarked appropriations were bundled together in seven budget proviso sub-sections located in Statewide Revenue, Part IB, Section 118, Page 531, Proviso 118.18, SR: Subsection (B) (73-77). Although your agency may not have requested the funds, it nevertheless was the recipient of one or more of these earmarked appropriations.

While the General Assembly took the unprecedented step of requiring the public disclosure of the sponsors and recipients these earmarked appropriations, it was not enough. I vetoed them because they lacked sufficient description or explanation as to how the recipient intends to spend the funds, and because they lacked proper accountability measures to ensure the funds are ultimately spent appropriately by the recipient. On June 29, 2021, the General Assembly overrode most of those vetoes.

Public transparency must be absolute and uncompromised in order to maintain the public's trust and confidence in their government. After all, it is the public's money which we are spending.

Therefore, pursuant to section 1-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws and article IV, section 17 of the South Carolina Constitution, I hereby direct that your agency "immediately furnish" a detailed explanation of how these funds will be spent by the recipient(s), along with a description of accountability measures being taken by the agency. I ask that this information be provided to the Executive Budget Office prior to disbursing funds to the recipient(s).
