

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.

2025-35

WHEREAS, by letter of September 16, 2025, a copy of which is attached hereto, the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Hampton County ("Board"), through the County Attorney, has advised the undersigned that a vacancy exists on the Town Council for the Town of Scotia and the "Town of Scotia passed the deadline for the filing and the election date"; and

WHEREAS, section 5-7-200(b) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, provides that "[a] vacancy in the office of mayor or council shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term at the next regular election or at a special election if the vacancy occurs one hundred eighty days or more prior to the next general election"; and

WHEREAS, the Board has advised the undersigned that the requisite election was not held due to a delay in notifying the Board of the resignation; and

WHEREAS, section 7-13-1170 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, provides as follows: "When any election official of any political subdivision of this State charged with ordering, providing for, or holding an election has neglected, failed, or refused to order, provide for, or hold the election at the time appointed, or if for any reason the election is declared void by competent authority, and these facts are made to appear to the satisfaction of the Governor, he shall, should the law not otherwise provide for this contingency, order an election or a new election to be held at the time and place, and upon the notice being given which to him appears adequate to insure the will of the electorate being fairly expressed. To that end, he may designate the existing election official or other person as he may appoint to perform the necessary official duties pertaining to the election and to declare the result."

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of South Carolina and pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of this State and the powers conferred upon me therein, I hereby Order that a special election shall be held on December 16, 2025, to fill the aforementioned vacancy on the Town Council for the Town of Scotia. Pursuant to section 7-

13-1170 of the South Carolina Code of Laws, as amended, I designate and appoint the Board to perform the necessary official duties pertaining to the special election, in accordance with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions, and to declare the results thereof. In order to qualify as a candidate to run in the special election, all candidates must file with the Board a statement of intention of candidacy, and submit any applicable filing fees, between noon on Friday, October 3, 2025, and noon on Monday, October 13, 2025. This Order is effective immediately.

Dear Governor McMaster:

I am sending this request in my capacity as Hampton County Attorney, representing for the purposes of this correspondence the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Hampton County's Board of Voter Registration regarding a special election to be held on December 16, 2025 for the Town of Scotia. The Town of Scotia passed the deadline for the filing and the election date, creating the need for a special election.

I have requested the Director of the Board of Voter Registration and Elections County/State to provide me with a suggested schedule for the election for your consideration. The Director has suggested the election be scheduled for December 16th, with Early Voting opening Monday, December 1st thru Friday December 12th for proposed election date. The Statement of Intention of Candidacy Non-Partisan form filing period would open the 3rd Friday of vacancy, being October 3rd at noon, until noon, October 13th.
